About the end of May I was approached by Pastor Scott and asked if I'd be interested in serving as a Pastor over the Oak Cliff location of their fellowship and I really sensed God in it. I have to be honest, I believe that this has been a set-up from God. For the last two-years, I've been longing to pour into a community of believers and see families made stronger through discipleship. I wasn't actually seeking a Pastor position, but I surrendered to the Lord who was placing this burden on me and I have to tell you that He sure did surprise me with this one! History...

The history of The Oaks Fellowship goes **back to 1921** when an evangelist came to the southern sector of Dallas to hold evangelistic meetings before there was ever a Church here. In 1945 a great man of God by the name of **H.C. Noah** (*I actually run with his grandson who is a Pastor: What's up Danny Noah!*) led what was then called Oak Cliff Assembly of God and was so honored and beloved by the community, he served the congregation for over 30 years. In the 80's Pastor Tom Wilson and his son Scott (*who was a youth pastor friend of mine when I was a youth pastor in the area*) took leadership and have done an awesome work in this area for 20 years. For the past 5 years the Church was led by Pastor Peter DeJesus who did an outstanding job in leading the congregation to the next level, so we're talking about a Church that has a long rich heritage.

Now...

The vision of the Oaks Fellowship is to plant 12 Churches in the DFW Metroplex by the year 2020. Under the leadership of Sr. Pastor Scott Wilson (Red Oak Location), our goal is to raise up one Church with multiple locations that serve the needs of the local community that the church is planted in. The Oak Cliff location serves as the first Church location plant with Lancaster TX coming on-line this fall and Desoto TX starting up next year. I am so excited to be a part of an innovative vibrant community of believers! We want to reach our communities and we believe God has given us a plan to do it!



The Future...

As far as the future, we will continue to do what God has given us with the discipleship of our young men in **U.G.P. (The Under-Ground Priesthood)** we really feel that this will be an even greater platform to complete their discipleship process and send them out to make a difference in the hip-hop community. **We really believe that God has given us an awesome opportunity to make a difference in the inner-city.**
